Diamond Park





Nearest Postcode: SA91ES

A two-minute walk from the apartment.

In between River Tawe Holiday
Apartment and Cafe Chameleon is the
Diamond Park, a former coal mine which
has now been reclaimed. According to
local hearsay, it was called diamond
because the coal that used to be found
there was very hard. Walk straight to the
top to look down on the town, or take a
right to explore the parkland and
continue onwards towards picnic
benches.

Just beyond is the beautiful Wern Plemys Nature Reserve managed by Brecknock Wildlife Trust. Consisting of both meadow and woodland it is home to several rare moth species. The Wildlife trust graze Exmoor ponies on this nature reserve and at Ystrad Fawr.

Sustrans Cycle Route no.43 runs above the village. Look out for the Café Chameleon by the river for a coffee, wine, beer or a bite to eat
